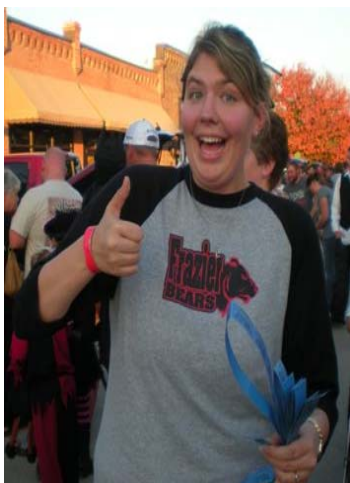

TEEN COURT



Teen Court is a voluntary program that would allow teens (12-19 years of age) with Class C misdemeanors “pay” for the citations through community service, educational classes, serving on a jury, and being involved in the judicial process.

The offenders will be judged by a jury of their own peers. Those involved must be in middle school or high school.

The real Teen Court started at 6:30 p.m. on May 28 at the Burleson sub-courthouse. As of May 5, approximately 15 cases were expected to be heard.

Subsequent Teen Court sessions will take place on the second Thursday of each month at 6:30 p.m.
